



WARM FUZZIES KNIT CAP

Materials: One or two skeins of Fizz or Multi Fizz. Mixing the eyelash with another yarn (wool, chenille, etc) will make a warmer and heavier hat.

Size 8 or 9 needle, according to your gauge

(may also use 16" circulars and DPs)

Gauge: 12 stitches and 16 rows = 4"

Sizes: Women's small, medium and large

For a child's hat: use about 10 stitches less and two inches shorter

DIRECTIONS:

Cast on 58 stitches

(55 stitches on a #10 when using heavier yarn or doubling your yarn)

(For a child's hat, cast on 50 stitches and knit 6 inches)

Knit 7 1/2" in garter stitch

Can also rib two inches and stockinette 6"

If you would like to add a rolled brim, knit the hat 2 inches longer

Decrease rows:

Row 1: Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, repeat across row

Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, repeat across row

Row 4 Knit

Row 5: Knit 1, Knit 2 together, Knit 1, Knit 2 together, repeat across row

Continue in the same manner (knit one row, decrease on next) until there are 8 stitches remaining.

Cut thread, leaving a 12" tail and run needle through remaining 8 stitches **pulling them up tight**. Sew side seam.

Needle size and number of stitches may be adjusted according to thickness of yarn used. Get creative, try doubling Yarn or using two different yarns together
